Discipline minutes for 3rd February 2008

Meeting opened at 8 15 pm

United Stars regarding outstanding fines

The committee discussed the reasons for the non payment of these fines with the club representatives present at the meeting and then within the guidelines of our rules arranged a mutually agreed payment plan to assist the club through their financial difficulties. The committee were also advised by the discipline secretary that the continued membership of this club should be tabled at the AGM for the existing members to decide.

Hayes United regarding outstanding fines

The committee discussed the reasons for the non payment of these fines with the club representatives present at the meeting and then within the guidelines of our rules cancelled a proportion of the fines and arranged a mutually agreed payment plan to assist the club through their financial difficulties.

The committee were also advised by the discipline secretary that this was the second time that this club had needed to be consulted regarding outstanding fines and that the continued membership of this club should be tabled at the AGM for the existing members to decide.

Sutton Common Rovers regarding outstanding fines

The committee discussed the reasons for the non payment of these fines with the club representatives present at the meeting, who then apologised for the late payment and settled their debt in full.

Appeal by Maiwand regarding fines for late kick off and no first aider as reported by the referee

The committee dealt with this on the written evidence supplied by the club as follows:-

The reason for the lack of a first aider was due to the league only running one course this season and they could not get a place on this course.

The committee decided that it is not an onus on the league to supply first aid courses and that all teams within this league as per FA rules are required to have a first aid person present at each game. The protest regarding this fine is therefore denied and the original fine will stand and is now due within 14 days of the date of these minutes. Protest fee forfeited.

The kick off was delayed due to the fact that the referee on inspection of the goal nets found them unsatisfactory and requested the home team to secure them properly

The committee decided that within the bounds of rule 10B (iv) and that due to their negligence the goal nets were not satisfactorily secured that the protest regarding this fine is therefore denied and the original fine will stand and is now due within 14 days of the date of these minutes. Protest fee forfeited.

Appeal by South Kilburn regarding failure to comply with status requirements for intermediate status, club members attended.

Protest regarding a referees report stating that no programme no refreshments and pitch not completely roped off during cup game v Bedfont Sports.

After listening to the report from the club representative their present the committee decided that even though the letter of the rule had been broken due to other problems on the day in question and the work done by the club to ensure the game went ahead the protest would be upheld and the fines regarding this would be cancelled. The club were however reminded that it is a necessity in their current division to ensure that this does not happen again.
