

Discipline Meeting held on the 3<sup>rd</sup> March at Brook House FC

Meeting started at 8 45 pm

Committee requested by League secretary to resolve outstanding games having been referred to discipline:-

#### **Haringey Town v North Hayes Academicals**

Home team ordered by league secretary to find a new ground due to the lack of facilities at their old ground rule 10B(vii). The ground supplied by them to the league was found to be 'double booked' on the day of the above game.

The Committee decided after due consideration that the home team had not made enough effort to get this match played and awarded an away win.

Home team to be dealt with under Rule 10 F (i)

#### **Osterley Royals v United Stars**

Away team under a county suspension until the Friday before this game, suspension not officially lifted by county until 3.30 pm on that day.

After hearing further evidence from the League Secretary Regarding this game the the Committee decided after due consideration that the game should be awarded to the home team. Rule 10(L).

#### **FC Tilburg Reserves v Bedfont Sports Reserves**

Away team failed to keep engagement.

The Committee decided after due consideration that the away team were at fault and should be dealt with accordingly

Away team failed to keep engagement within the bounds of rule 10(B)(xii).

#### **Indian Gymkhana v Barnet Town**

Home team referred to discipline due to discrepancies on their team sheet

After reviewing all the evidence the Committee decided that there was no case to answer and that the result on the day should stand.

### **Junior All Stars v Haringey Town**

Away team failed to keep engagement within the bounds of rule 10(B)(xii).

The Committee decided after due consideration that the away team were at fault and should be dealt with accordingly

### **Neasden v Kings Meadow**

Home team referred to discipline due to the wrong name being given to the referee for a booking.

The team manager apologised to the referee at the end of the game and gave the correct name also at the time producing the id card relevant to that player, who has since been dealt with by the club internally

### **Haringey Town v Junior All Stars**

Away team failed to keep engagement within the bounds of rule 10(B)(xii).

### **Feltham town v Stanwell United**

Still awaiting an FA appeal decision

### **Barnhill Explorers v Stanwell United**

The committee decided that the result in this game should stand Rule 10(F)(ix) and no further action to be taken

### **Blue Marlin v Junior All Stars**

Game not played due to the late arrival of away team.

The late arrival of the away team was due to a breakdown in the transport for five of their players ie:- one car (this was verified by a report from the AA after the team had arrived) their attempts to get to the match are well documented and quite understandable.

The home team's agreement to a delayed kick off time and their communications with the opponents are also well documented including their need to buy nets on the day.

Having looked at the evidence supplied from both teams via email the committee felt that on this occasion, due to the relevance of the game, that it should be rescheduled at the earliest possible date.

#### **Protest by Sporting Hounslow re Fines No2784/2785/2786**

The Committee decided after due consideration of the evidence supplied by the club that the fines on this occasion should be withdrawn.

Protest upheld and fee refunded.

#### **Protest received from The Wanderers**

Not heard as the committee were informed that the protest was outside the seven day's as allowed in our rules.

Committee decided that the fines should stand and the club have 14 days from the date of these minutes to comply.

Letter received from Bedham Fc with reference to a league officer the Discipline Secretary to reply to the club.
