Meeting Commenced at 7:45 PM

Registrations, Secretary still covering for Warren and confirmed that Janet Hosmer, Julian Bauer and SCH attended Rachael's funeral 5th January in Torquay, Bob Langley had suggested that as a league we might consider a Rachael McMahon memorial Cup, JMH and SCH confirmed they had mentioned this very briefly to Warren when they had seen him and his family on the 31st December 2009, and that they would discuss this further with them.

SCH would chase Bob Langley to concentrate on the various Cup Competitions but Bob was already doing this, the County Cups were causing major problems with clubs failing to understand the rules of the County Cups especially that if the match was postponed you had to play the following week regardless of having a home pitch or not, and equally not thinking about moving the game over to the opponents.

Referees- again due to lack of games no problems currently but the County Cups causing problems if the match had been postponed the previous week as the original referee was re appointed.

Hayes & District Sunday Youth Football League, SCH confirmed that discussions were still progressing regarding the merger and that he and the Chairman would be attending a League Council meeting with the clubs, and that SCH would be attending a further management meeting with the Committee but that the both FJ and SCH felt that the merger would progress.

Discipline Chairman:

Again due to lack of games not much to either report or deal with, one club Discover was causing major concerns, but appears to have gained administration help from their local council after a discussion looking at the level of fines for basically admin errors, and looking at the sportsmanship marks from referees and their on the field discipline reports it was agreed that the club be closely monitored over the next few weeks to see if they have made any improvements.
